INTERVIEW WITH MOSES THE RING MASTER

Q Some people describe you as ring master. Would you agree?

A **The ring master leads and directs all the people in the circus, and God called me to lead and direct the Israelites as they left Egypt so I suppose you could say I was sort of a ring master.**

Q Were you a young man when God called you for this task?

A **No I had already had an eventful life, I was actually about 80 at the time.**

Q How did God get your attention?

A **I was tending my father-in-law's sheep when I saw a bush which looked as if it was on fire, but it did not burn up. So I thought, "I will go over and see this strange sight—why the bush does not burn up." When the LORD saw that I had gone over to look, He called to me from within the bush, "Moses! Moses!" And I said, "Here I am."**

Q What did God tell you to do?

A **He told me He knew how the Egyptians were mistreating the Israelites and that I was to go to Pharaoh and tell him to let the people go.**

Q To give you such a difficult task, God must have chosen you because you were a very confident person?

A, **No, not at all. I asked God "Who am I, that I should go to Pharaoh and bring the Israelites out of Egypt?" He told me what I was to say to Pharaoh, and also what I should say to the Israelites if they didn't want to follow me.**

Q What was the most important thing you learnt through it all?

A **I learnt that God is faithful and He keeps His promises. When I put my trust in Him, He kept his promise to help me and I became a great leader.**
