1. Quickly brainstorm what type of things you think are important or precious to most people?
2. Read 2:4-5. If believers are being built into a spiritual house, does this have any implications for our 'togetherness' as Christians?
3. As a holy priesthood, we are to be offering 'spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God.' What do you think these are? (See Heb 13:15-16 & Rom 12:1) How might we encourage each other to do this more?
4. Read v6-7. Jesus is described as precious to God (also in 1:19). Consider Matt 13:44-46. Why do you think Christians should view Jesus as precious and what effect on our lives will that have? Think of how we can remind ourselves how precious he is?
5. Read v9-10. To whom do you think we are called to declare the praises (or excellences – ESV) to? And what are those excellences?
6. Does this passage teach us anything about how precious we are to God (2:4-10)? And what hope does it provide (don't miss v6)?

- If there was one thing you could highlight that God is challenging you about to pray over / change / seek His help in, what is it?
- Is there one thing you are going to take away with you as an encouragement?
- What can others pray for you to help you respond to His challenge?
